

# W115 Flat/Saddle Stapler

## Use Only skrebba® Heavy Duty Staples



### **Loading Staples**

- Open the staple magazine until it reaches its stop.
- 2. Insert a full strip of staples (up to 200 staples)
- Push the staple magazine back in until it latches

**Note:** If the magazine is not securely latched, staples will not be released.



#### **Flat Stapling**

- 1. Loosen the Wing Nut on the right side of the Gooseneck.
- Lift the Table and slide back towards the stapling head so that the Opening For Anvil (Saddle) fits into the tab extending from the Base. (Note: The Bracket on the Gooseneck will slide up to allow for flat stapling)
- 3. Push back into the tab on the base, then down over the anvil.
- 4. Once the table is in position for flat stapling, the anvil must be seen through the Opening For Anvil (Flat), at the center of the table.
- 5. Tighten the wing nut.
- 6. Adjust the Paper Backstop as desired for the approprate throat depth.

# Saddle Stapling

- 1. Loosen the wing nut on the right side of the gooseneck.
- 2. Lift the table and slide it forward and down (away from the stapling head) so that the anvil fits into the opening used for saddle stapling. (Note: The Bracket on the Gooseneck will slide down for saddle position).
- 3. Center the table over the anvil in the saddle position.
- 4. Tighten the wing nut.

Caution: To avoid injury, do not place fingers on the anvil or under the stapling head.

Note: In case of a staple jam...

Put the stapler in the Flat Stapling position. Place a 1/2" tall block of wood (not provided) on the table underneath the stapling head with-out blocking the opening where the staples dispense. Press down on the Lever until the jammed staple is removed.
