Unlock the key and remove the top case.



Plug the Transformer into an available AC Outlet. Plug the opposite end of the wire from the transfromer into the T-4U. A time should now be displayed.

4, PROGRAMMING THE T-4U

To enter the program setting mode, remove the case cover and plug the AC adapter into the AC outlet. Next press the <u>SELECT</u> button once. The recorder will enter the program mode showing a ▲ on the display positioned at the "TIME" mark.



5、 SETTING THE TIME

EX: To set the T-4U to 09:30 AM from some other arbitrary time.



Note:

Failure to complete step 4, will result in the time stamp not printing.

EX:Set the T-4U's date to September 2 of 2003



Press the <u>SELECT</u> button, and position the ▲ under the "DATE ". The "YEAR" will flash.



Press the <u>CHANGE</u> button until "03" is displayed, then press the <u>SET</u> button. The "Month" should now flash.





Press the CHANGE button until "02" is displayed, then press the SET button. The T-4U's date is now set, press the SET button once again to return the machine to normal operations and time display.

If other functions need to be set please press the SELECT button, or replace and lock the case cover.

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EX:Set the hour format to 24 hour



Press the <u>SELECT</u> button and position the ▲ under the "HOUR" mark. The flashing digit indicates the "hour display format options".



Press the <u>CHANGE</u> button to advance to mode "2", then press the <u>SET</u> button.

The T-4U's Hours Display Format is now set, press the <u>SET</u> button once again to return the machine to normal operations and time display.

If other functions need to be set please press the <u>SELECT</u> button, or replace and lock the case cover.

EX:Set the print order to "Month, Date, Year, Hour, Minute"



Press the SELECT button and position the ▲ under the "PRINT ORDER"mark. The flashing digit indicates the currently selected "PrintOrder Options".



Press the CHANGE button until"5" is displayed, then press the SET button.

10, Hour/Minute Print Format

EX:Set the print format for "Hour" and "Minute" to 24 hour and 1/100hr





Press the SELECT button and position the \blacktriangle under ' MIN "mark. The flashing digit indicates the selected "Hour Options".

Press the CHANGE button until 2 is displayed. Press the SET button to save the displayed value. The flashing digit shifts from "Hour" to" Minute".

The T-4U's Hour and Minute Print Format Options are now set, press the SET button once again to return the machine to normal operations and time display.

If other functions need to be set please press the <u>SELECT</u> button, or replace and lock the case cover.

Failure to complete step 2, will result in the time stamp not printing.

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11, Day (Date) Print Format

EX:Disable the leading "O" in the Day of the Month (Date)



Press the SELECT button and position the ▲ under " Leading "mark. The flashing digit indicates "Leading Zero Options"

Press the <u>CHANGE</u> button until "1" is displayed. Press the <u>SET</u> button to save the displayed value.

The T-4U's Day Of The Month Print Format Option is now set, press the <u>SET</u> button once again to return the machine to normal operations and time display.

If other functions need to be set please press the <u>SELECT</u> button, or replace and lock the case cover.

Note:

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EX:Set the comment to "FAXED" (This setting is available if "Comment" is selected in the "PRINT ORDER".)



Press the SELECT button and position the ▲ under " COMMENT "mark. The flashing digit indicates the current "Comment Options".



Press the CHANGE button to scroll, until "9" appears. Press the SET button to save the displayed value.

The T-4U's Comment Option is now set, press the SET button once again to return the machine to normal operations and time display.

If other functions need to be set please press the <u>SELECT</u> button, or replace and lock the case cover.

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EX:Print date and comment in Spanish. (This setting is available if "Comment" is selected in the "PRINT ORDER".) 2

EX: Change the print direction to "Left" and the print activation to "Automatic".



15, SETTING THE DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

EX:Start, date Thursday, MAY 1, 2003. END date Wednesday October 1, 2003

Given the international example above, the time recorder remembers the starting date of DST as the first Thrsday in MAY and the last Wednesday in October. If we set the DST start and stop dates for the current year, the T4U will automatically update the DST dates each year.





The starting date of D.S.T is now configured, press the <u>SET</u> button once again to return to the normal time display.

It is recommended that the "SETTING THE ENDING DATE OF DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME" is completed at this time.

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EX - (continued): Daylight saving time ends on Wednesday October 1,2003



Note:

Failure to complete step 4, will result in the time stamp not printing.

Press the CHANGE button until "10" <u>is displayed</u>. Press the <u>SET</u> button to save the selection. "Date" will begin

Press the CHANGE button until "01" is displayed. Press the SET button to save the

The T-4U's Daylight Savings Mode Option is now set, press the SET button once again to return the machine to normal operations and time

If other functions need to <u>be set p</u>lease press the SELECT button, or replace and lock the case cover.

> To clear either the Month or Date field select "--". Setting both the Month and Date fields as "--" will disable the Daylight Savings function. Please remember to set both DST Start and DST End Modes appropriately.

EX:Set the password to "1234" (The password can be set from "0000" to "9999")



Note:

Failure to complete step 3, will result in the time stamp not printing.

If a password has been set in the T-4U, programming changes may not be made until the proper password has been entered. "9999" will be displayed when the <u>SELECT</u> button is first pressed.

Press the <u>CHANGE</u> button to advance the displayed digits to "12". Press the <u>SET</u> button to save the displayed value. The last two digits will now flash.





Press the <u>CHANGE</u> button to advance the displayed digits to "34". Press the <u>SET</u> button to save the displayed value.

Press the SET button to verify the password. If the correct password has been entered the ▲ cursor will indicate . Select the desired setting mode by pressing the SELECT button.

Should the password no longer be necessary for a given application it may be cleared by entering a 'password' of "0000".



The T-4U may be re-initialized to its factory settings by pressing the recessed Reset Switch. After the Reset Switch is pressed theT-4U may need to be re-programmed for a given job assignment.

Please note: All functions and settings including passwords will be cleared when the Reset Switch is pressed.



20, WALL MOUNTING

Select a suitable location to mount the T-4U that is reasonably close to an AC wall outlet (within 6ft/2m of wire cord length), a wooden installation (backing) board should be used to mount the T-4U to the surface of the wall.
 The T-4U should be mounted 48 inches(122 CM) above the floor.

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21, REPLACING THE RIBBON CASSETTE



Unlock the key remove the cover.





Hold the ribbon cassette by its tab and pull straight out to remove it.



Turn the knob of the new cassette in the direction of the arrow to tighten the ribbon.

Place the cassette inside the time recorder as shown in the figure. Push the ribbon until it snaps intoposition. Turning the knob on the ribbon cassette may make installation easier.





Turn the knob of the cassette in the direction of the arrow to tighten the ribbon.



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Replace the cover and lock. The T-4U may now be used to imprint documents.

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22, ERROR CODES

Code	Problem	Solution
P-01	CPU error	Call the servicing dealer from

P-06	Incorrect password.	Enter the correct password.
P-07	Daylight Savings Time setting mistake.	Verify the correct staring and ending date of dayling saving time and re-enter again.
P08	Date entered is invalid.	Refer to your owner's manual on the page related to the item.

Other Trouble Issues

- 1. The T-4U does not operate Ensure the AC adapter is properly
 plugged into the AC outlet and the T4U.
 Verify AC Power is available in the outlet.
- 2. The T-4U does not print Ensure the ribbon is installed correctly and the proper print method is set.
- 3. The document is jammed -Press the push bar and try to pull out the document at the same time.
